Day 1	USA – Quito
Morning	Fly to Quito, Ecuador, via major scheduled airline.
Afternoon	Arrive at Quito International Airport.

	Quito, the capital of Ecuador, presents a wonderful mix of a modern city with colonial era constructions. Temples, monasteries and mansion from the $16^{th}$ and $17^{th}$ century are part of this great urban destination.

#### Morning <u>City Sightseeing Tour</u>

We will start the tour in the 'old town', visiting the **Independence Plaza**, surrounded by historical buildings like the **Basilica**, **Presidential Palace**, and **Municipal Building**. There you will also appreciate the first religious building constructed in South America by the Spanish: the **Church of San Francisco**.

We will also go to the famous **Church of the Society of Jesus**, an ornate Jesuit building with a colonial Baroque design.

Later, we will visit **El Panecillo**, a volcanic hill with an incredible view of the city, where we will be able to examine the **"Virgin of Quito" statue**.

Finally, we will be transferred to the modern part of Quito, specifically to "La Carolina" city park, in order to visit the botanical garden of Quito, and finishing with a drive through the residential neighborhoods in this part of the city.

Afternoon Transfer back to your hotel. Rest of the afternoon at leisure.

### Otavalo - Full-Day Tour







Depart Quito after breakfast and visit **Cochasqui**, considered the most important archaeological site in Ecuador's Northern Andes. Explore the ruins of pre-Incan pyramids, used in the religious ceremonies of Caranqui Indians.

Continue your journey to Otavalo, explore the famous market to see the colorful textiles and learn about the rich history and culture of the area.

After a morning of shopping and discovery, we will visit the attractive nearby towns of **Cotacachi** and **Peguche.** 

Time for lunch before returning back to Quito.

## Day 4 Quito

We will drive 25 km. north to "Mitad del Mundo" (literally middle of the world) where the Equatorial Line Monument is located. At this point the North and South hemispheres meet, and you can stand with one foot in each half of the planet!

Afternoon Return to Quito. Free time for lunch and to explore the city before your concert.

## Day 5 Cotopaxi - Riobamba

Transfer to Cotopaxi National Park.

## Morning & Afternoon

#### Cotopaxi National Park excursion







We will be driven south of Quito through the famous avenue of the volcanoes, on our way to the Cotopaxi National Park.

Once in the park we will visit the **museum**, the **'Limpio Pungo'** Lagoon, Inca ruins called **'El Salitre'**, and we will stop for lunch at a mountain refugee with an amazing view of the world's highest active volcano. The park is also home to a wide variety of local wildlife including wild horses, llamas and the elusive Andean Condor.

After Lunch we will continue our way to Riobamba.

Riobamba is a charming city located in the heart of the central highlands, where you will be able to enjoy its picturesque parks, museums and 18th century churches.

Arrive and check in at hotel.

#### **Devil's Nose Full-day Tour**

After the train ride we will visit the **Ingapirca Inca Ruins**, the biggest Inca archaeological complex in Ecuador that dates from the XV and XVI centuries.

Transfer to your hotel in Cuenca and check in.

## Day 7 Cuenca

Cuenca, consider by the locals "the most beautiful city in Ecuador" was declared a World Heritage Site by the Unesco.

**Panama Hats** 

First we will start the tour of the city of Cuenca by visiting the **Calderon Park**, where you will appreciate the **new neo-gothic cathedral**, built in 1880, with its distinctive blue dome that dominates Cuenca's skyline. Right across is the **old cathedral**, built by the Spanish in 1557, the year the city was founded.

Afterward, we will stop at the **Cañari-Incas ruins** at Pumapungo and then explore the **City Museum**.

Later you will have the opportunity to visit a **Panama hat factory**. Ironically, Panama hats hail from Cuenca, not Panama.
